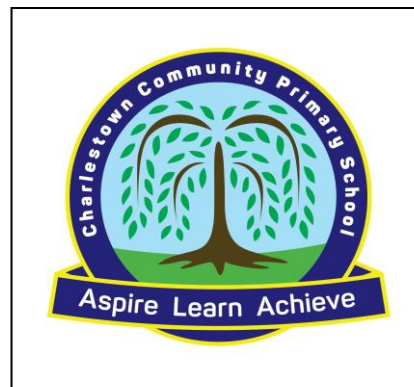

<b>N.B. The 16 children who did not pass the Phonic screen test in year 2 , 4 were EAL, 9 SEND and 1 was new to school just prior to the phonic screen week. All the children who re took the test but did not pass did improve on scores from year 1.</b>						

Progress from KS1 to KS2: This has previously been measured using levels. In 2016 a child's average point score in Key Stage 1 has been used to measure progress which is different from using previous levels.
