After half term, we will be welcoming our new executive head, Mr Reed, to the team.



Thank you for supporting our work on the gate and outside school to keep our children safe, we have seen a huge improvement which enables us to keep the children as safe as possible.

HOWEVER, we did experience a very near-miss the other morning, two children crossing the road - unaccompanied AND on the bend, were very lucky not to be seriously hurt. A car had stopped to let children cross (next to a parked car) and another car then overtook this car on the bend. We have footage of this incident and have shared with the Council.

You may have noticed that Manchester City Council has responded to the concerns we have raised and have sent a camera vehicle to support us. They have shared the following:

- -Vehicles parked or stopped on double yellow lines will receive an automatic fine.
- -Vehicles which stop or park on the yellow zig-zag lines will receive an automatic fine.
- -Vehicles that stop/park on the white lines outside a house will receive an automatic fine.

A big issue is the way taxi drivers drive and their attitude. If you use a taxi for the school run, please encourage your driver to stop/drop off in a sensible place, not on the bend or the middle of the road.
