



<p><b>House making</b></p> <p>Create your own house using a recyclable bottle, glue and natural resources like stones and twigs.</p>  <p>MAKE A FAIRY HOUSE OUT OF PEBBLES, GROUT AND A BOTTLE!</p> <p>It could be the habitat for something or someone. E.g a superhero, Lego figures, fairies or magical creatures.</p>	<p><b>Square it up</b></p> <p>You need six drinking straws each the same length. Cut two of them in half. You now have eight straws, four long and four short.</p> <p>You can make 2 squares from the eight straws.</p>  <p>Arrange your eight straws to make 3 squares, all the same size.</p>	<p><b>Circuit Training/ Obstacle Course</b></p> <p>Design and create several activities you could do on an obstacle course.</p>  <p>Create a circuit of them in the garden or in the house (with permission of course). Safely use different items to create the course. Have a look online for further ideas. 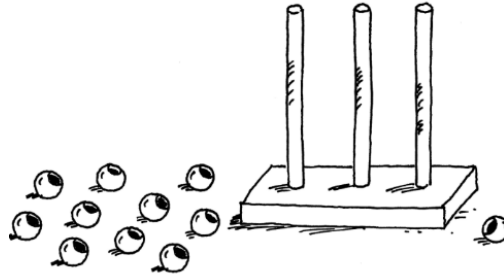
### Song Writers
