# Creative Jungle Collage

#### **Exercise Maths**


Complete three physical challenges to generate two target numbers. E.G. Count how many star jumps you can do in 30 seconds - Time how long you can hop on the spot on one foot for. Add the numbers together, Subtract the smaller number from the higher one. Find if either number can be divided equally, using small toys or counters to help you.



#### Challenge

Find as many ways of making each number as you can. For example, for the number 28 you might note that 14 + 14 = 28, or that 25 + 3 = 28, etc.
