What YOU must do:

- Telephone the school before 9am each day of your child's absence unless agreed otherwise. 0161 740 3529 option 2
- Tell the school in advance of any medical appointments and bring in appointment cards/letters.
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway as they often perk up on arrival.
- If your child is unwell and goes to the doctor or hospital, provide a doctor's note to school. If medication is prescribed a clear picture of the name and date prescribed can be emailed to aslam.n@charlestown.manchester.sch.uk or shown at the school office. This ensures the absence is authorised on medical grounds.
- Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

- Check your child's attendance every day.
- Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.
- If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit
- Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.
